**SUBJECT: 1999 Agricultural Research Report**

**Submitted is the 1999 Report of Agricultural Research conducted by the Montana Agricultural Experiment Station at Research Centers with funds received from the Montana Wheat and Barley Committee.**

**The main emphasis of research, with funding assistance from the Montana Wheat and Barley Committee, is to investigate various aspects of dryland continuous and/or flexible cropping systems as compared to traditional crop-fallow systems; and the appropriateness of various materials and practices as components of cropping systems in general.**

**This report has been bound according to subject matter and not by location in order that the reader may more easily refer to certain aspects of the research.**

**Off-station winter wheat variety evaluations in the Western Triangle Area were lost to poor winter survival. Off-station spring wheat and barley variety evaluations at Turner were cancelled due to sustained, above normal precipitation delaying planting beyond the window considered reasonable for meaningful, long-term research purposes on the Big Flat (June).**
